

Allison Metz, Ph.D., is a developmental psychologist and Co-Director of the National Implementation Research Network (NIRN) and Senior Scientist at the Frank Porter Graham Child Development Institute at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Allison specializes in the implementation, mainstreaming, and scaling of evidence to achieve social impact for children and families in a range of human service and education areas, with an emphasis on child welfare and early childhood service contexts.

Allison serves on several national advisory boards and is an invited speaker and trainer internationally. She is currently a Co-Chair for the Global Implementation Conference, a part of the Global Implementation Initiative. She is co-editor of the recently published volume *Application of Implementation Science to Early Childhood Program and Systems*.
