The human trafficking legislation would:

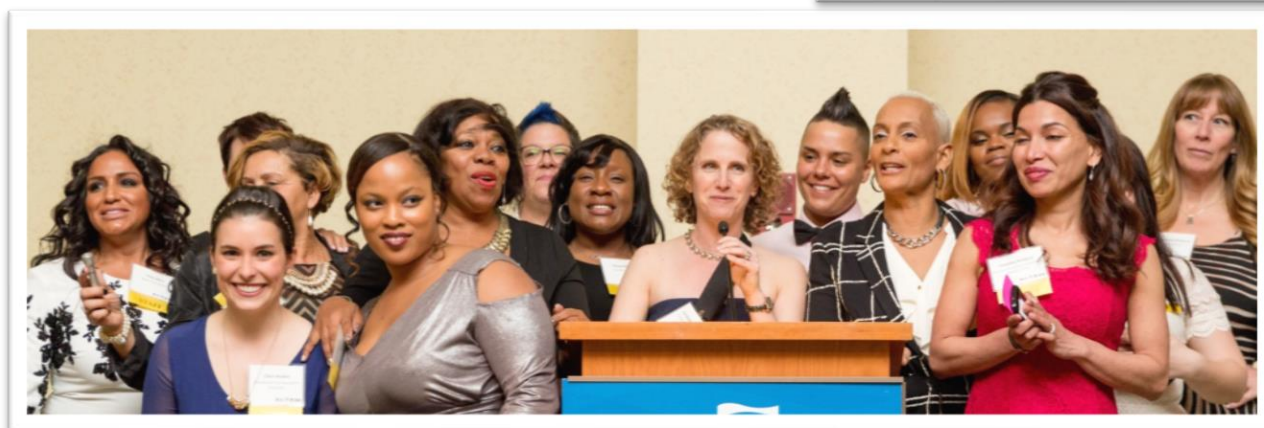
- ◉ Create the crime of trafficking of persons for sexual purposes
